

# Covid19 Safety Acknowledgement, Liability Waiver and Release of Claims

COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is spread mainly from person-to-person contact. The American Saddlebred Horse Association of Alberta (ASHA of Alberta) Charity Horse Show has put in place preventative measures to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19, however, the ASHA of Alberta Charity Horse Show cannot guarantee that its participants, volunteers, partners, or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19.

In light of the ongoing spread of COVID-19, individuals who fall within any of the categories below should not attend the show. By attending the 2021 ASHA of Alberta Charity Horse Show, you certify the following:

1. You do not currently nor within the past fourteen (14) days have experienced any symptoms associated with COVID-19, which include;

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

2. You have not traveled at any time within the past fourteen (14) days internationally or are not otherwise required by a government authority to self-isolate.

3. You do not believe that you may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19, nor have you been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious by the doctor responsible for your treatment.

## **DUTY TO SELF-MONITOR and REPORT:**

You agree to self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and will immediately end your attendance at the Show if symptoms develop. You also agree that in such event you will immediate contact Alberta Health Services at 811 for instructions.

## **ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK**

**I acknowledge and understand the following:**

- 1. Participation in the ASHA of Alberta Charity Horse Show includes possible exposure to illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While the protocols that ASHA of Alberta Charity Horse Show has put in place and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist;**
- 2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, even if arising from the negligence or fault of the Released Parties.**

### **COVID-19 LIABILITY WAIVER AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS:**

#### **READ IT CAREFULLY!**

IN CONSIDERATION OF BEING ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE 2021 ASHA OF ALBERTA CHARITY HORSE SHOW I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AND DEMANDS OF WHATEVER KIND OR NATURE, WHETHER IN LAW OR IN EQUITY, AGAINST ASHA OF ALBERTA CHARITY HORSE SHOW, AND ITS AFFILIATED PARTNERS AND SPONSORS, INCLUDING IN EACH CASE, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS, VOLUNTEERS, AND AGENTS (THE "RELEASED PARTIES"), WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE, FAULT OR CONDUCT OF ANY KIND OF THE RELEASED PARTIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DEATH, BODILY INJURY, ILLNESS, ECONOMIC LOSS, OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES, LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, WHICH I, MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN AND/OR LEGALLY APPOINTED OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVES, MAY HAVE OR WHICH MAY HEREINAFTER ACCRUE ON MY BEHALF, WHICH ARISE OR MAY HEREAFTER ARISE FROM MY PARTICIPATION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE 2021 ASHA OF ALBERTA CHARITY HORSE SHOW, AND RESULTING FROM ILLNESS FROM INFECTIOUS DISEASES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO COVID-19.
