## PERSON(S) RESPONSIBLE

The **Person(s) responsible** (PR) for a horse must be an adult who has, or shares responsibility for the care, training, custody, and performance of the horse and who has official responsibility for that horse under EC Rules. The PR is liable under the penalty provisions of the applicable EC Rules for any rule violations. Every entry form for an EC sanctioned competition must identify the PR and be signed by the PR.

The **Person(s) responsible** is ultimately responsible for the condition, fitness and management of the horse and is alone responsible for any act performed by himself/herself or by any other person with authorized

access to the horse in the stables, elsewhere on the grounds, or while the horse is being ridden, driven or exercised.

**A:** For adult entries into EC sanctioned competitions the PR shall be either the trainer, the owner of the horse of the competitor who rides or drives the horse during the EC sanctioned competition. *Section A Page 101*

**B:** For Junior entries into EC sanctioned competitions the Junior competitor cannot be the PR. For Junior entries the PR may be either the trainer, the owner of the horse, or a parent/guardian of the Junior competition

#### STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

The Equestrian Canada Federation (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed under their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person/**person responsible**, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane. Neither the Parkland Spring Horse Show Committee nor the Management or Owner of the Westerner Park nor any of its staff or agents shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage, loss, or for any other matter that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to exhibitors, competitors, or members or their agents or to anyone on the show grounds or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on the show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with, arising out of, or attributable to the show or any journey to or from the show. It is to be understood and agreed that under no circumstances shall Parkland or Westerner Park, its owner, agents or employees be liable for any loss, damages, claims or costs occasioned or suffered by an exhibitor, competitor or their agents directly or indirectly howsoever arising, including without limitation, losses, damages, claims or costs as a result of Parkland or Westerner Park, its owners, agents or employees' negligence and you agree to indemnify and save harmless Parkland or Westerner Park, its owners, agents, and employees from any claim against any liability arising out of any such loss, damages, claims or costs. **The Show** Committee reserves the right to add, amend, or delete any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary changes in the Prize List or Program.

Membership to EC is now called a Sport License. *All exhibitors, owners, trainers, riders, drivers, handlers **must** join EC with a sport license to be able to compete in any EC sanctioned show. One show per year will allow a temporary membership, see EC rules.*

**Amateur Competitors:** All adults competing in EC AMATEUR classes require a current Amateur card.

This must be applied for at the same time as the "Sport License" through Equestrian Canada.

– **no additional fee** for Amateur Status however you must complete the application on the EC website by checking the amateur status.

If Amateur status is not showing on your Sport Horse license then you must contact EC to get the correct card.

### AHA Membership Statement - AHA Comp 301.10

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) and signing the entry blank in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership or competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA single membership fee for competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and the agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in Walk/Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National Competitions.

**Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements.**

All exhibitors entered in this event must be a current AHA member or pay a Single Event Membership fee of **\$35.00 US funds / \$40 Canadian funds** per person this includes one owner, any trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.

Canadian Exchange is collected on any AHA Show Fees. AHA Single Event fees are as indicated on the entry form.

## AHA New Qualification Rules

1. Qualification period is the previous year plus the current year up to the close of entries. (Placings in year 2021 count towards next year's qualification period – if your placing was not previously recorded, you will need to qualify in year 2022 under the participation system)
2. Compete in any qualifying AHA Recognized show in any region (which includes Concurrent, Pre-Show, Value Show).
3. An Amateur must qualify the horse to participate in an Amateur or Amateur Owner class.
4. Compete in a recognized section, i.e.-HA/AA Western Pleas., Arabian Country English Pleas., Arabian Hunter Pleasure, etc.
5. Compete in any recognized class within that section (Note: for Dressage, each level is considered its own section).
6. Participate in that one recognized class in that section now qualifies you to compete in as many classes within that section at any one Regional Championship Show of your choice.  
(a. Example: Participate at a qualifying show in HA/AA Western Pleasure ATR qualifies for any and as many classes in HA/AA Western Pleasure as long as you meet the definition for an Amateur, Amateur Owner, Leveling, Jr. Horse, etc.  
The qualification could have been earned in Region 8 but was used for the Region 6 Championship Show.)
7. Participate at two (2) AHA Qualifying Shows and compete at any & as many Regional Championships in that section.
8. Equitation is based on the rider and the rider must participate in their qualifying section.
  - A. Youth - National Championship Show, a rider must win:
    1. A Medal, in a class of three or more entries; or
    2. obtain participation qualifications in AHA Medal classes (see current chart); or
    3. a Top Five or better from corresponding classes in Regional Championship Shows, East Coast Championship or Pacific Slope Championship, or a Top Six or better from corresponding classes in Eastern or Western Canadian Breeders Championship Classes.
  - B. Adult - National Championship Show, a rider must win:
    1. obtain participation qualifications in classes requiring a pattern; or
    2. a Top Five or better from corresponding classes in Regional Championship Shows, East Coast Championship or Pacific Slope Championship, or a Top Six or better from corresponding classes in Eastern or Western Canadian Breeders Championship Classes.
9. Participation can also be used to qualify in Specialty classes and can be obtained through Open Shows (and placings for Working Western/Dressage/Western Dressage).
10. A National Show Commission has the right to place restrictions on cross entry into classes.
11. The USEF/EC family definition and two distinct non-family owner definition must be adhered to.
12. East Coast and Pacific Slope (Top Five), Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders (Top Six) all count as Regional Placings.
13. Participation definition:
  - a. In a class where horses compete together, participated means a horse/rider/driver/handler must have been entered, shown, and judged (perform at all required gaits both ways of the ring and remain in the ring until excused by the judge). In other words, finishing the class.
  - b. In a class where horses compete individually, participated means a horse/rider must have completed the individual requirements of the class and be eligible to receive a score.
  - c. Horses which are excused/disqualified/eliminated/ received a "no score" are not considered adjudicated.

## Rules and Regulations

These shows are conducted in accordance with the rules of EC and AHA. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of the rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections will automatically become part of this Prize List. Questions that arise, that are not covered by either AHA or EC rulebooks, will be decided by the Parkland Show Committee and their decisions will be final.

Protests must be made by an EC License holder (or by an exempt person as defined by Article A214) in writing to the Show Secretary of the competition at which the matter under consideration occurs, must be signed and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$100 in cash and must be served within 48 hours of completion of the class concerned (per EC rules).

## General Rules

### 1. All entries must:

- ✓ have each owner's entry on a separate form;
- ✓ full address of owner (plus that of the trainer and/or authorized agent);
- ✓ signature of owner (plus that of the trainer or authorized agent) or the adult and person responsible ;
- ✓ copies of all membership cards, this includes AHA, CMHA, ASHAC, & EC & AEF (PSO)
- ✓ Amateur Owner / Rider and Junior Exhibitor cards;
- ✓ a copy of each horse's registration papers (front and back);
- ✓ include funds to cover entry, stall rental, drug fees and all required fees shown on entry form.

### 2. All E-transfers, cheques, money orders or drafts are to be made payable to the Parkland Arabian Horse Association.

No post-dated cheques will be accepted for Entry Fees, Stabling, Sponsorships or Advertising.

### 3. Horses entering any classes (except those listed as All Breeds) must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR), the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the AHA or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association (CMHA); the American Saddlebred Horse Association of Canada (ASHAC); or any other duly recognized registry if the horse is owned by a citizen of a foreign country. For greater clarity, an American Saddlebred or Morgan owned by an American citizen may be entered with a name and registration number from the American Saddlebred Horse Association or the American Morgan Horse Association. Horses must be entered under their full registered name with their registration number, or if an age specified by breed rules, as eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the name(s) of the owner or lessee of record with the breed association. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease must be submitted with the entry form at the time the entry is made.

### 4. Post entries will be accepted at the show at "the per horse post-entry fee & regular class fee rate" up to one full session prior to the post-entered class.

### 5. Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location." . A602.5

### 6. As of January 1, 1991, All Arabian sanctioned AHA Shows must collect a mandatory fee per horse entered per show of \$5.00 US funds CONVERTS TO \$7.00 Canadian. This is in accordance to the 1990 Convention Resolution #9/90 that addressed mandatory funding for the new Judges, Commission and Education/Evaluation Committee. To compensate for the US exchange rate, the Parkland Spring Show will be charging \$7.00 CDN per show to those entering horses in Arabian or Half/Arabian classes to cover this fee. This fee will be refunded to owners following the current vet out ruling per AHA Rules. AHA 602.5

### 7. ARTICLE A1006 Examination – Sample & Collect for drug testing by EC staff - the recommendation of the chair or the chair's delegate, the technician or the licensed veterinarian may select for sample collection and testing of any horse entered in any class at an EC-sanctioned competition.

### 8. Management reserves the right to reject any entry at any time for any reason the Officials deem reasonable cause.

### 9. No entry fee will be refunded except on receipt of a Veterinarian's Certificate, which is required and must be presented to the Show Secretary. No refunds of entry fees for any reason after 8:00 am, Friday, May 20, 2021. A \$20 fee will be deducted from any refund to cover processing expenses. There is no substitution of horses for any reason unless approved by show management with extenuating circumstances. Show will also retain the office fee and back number fee.

### 10. A charge of \$50.00 will be levied for cheques returned by the bank for any reason. Exhibitors with returned cheques will not be allowed to show unless a certified cheque, cash or money order is presented to the Show Office prior to the start of classes on Friday, May 21, 2021 – 8:00am.

### 11. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes having fewer than 3 entries at closing of entries. Exhibitors will be notified if classes are cancelled due to low entries. All changes will be posted at the Show Office. Please verify your classes and fees on the Acknowledgement emailed to you.

### 12. Mandatory fees are Office - \$30.00, Drug fee - \$5.00, & Back Number- \$5.00 - each horse entry additional AHA fees for Arabians/HA/AA are – Res.9/90 - \$7.00, Show - \$7.00 .- TBA's with entries \$25 plus AHA fee \$20 CDN

### 13. Calls or emails will be made to exhibitors by the Show Secretary if deemed necessary to clarify any entry.

### 14. If entry forms are not completely correct they may be returned at the discretion of the Show Secretary. Entries missing priority items such as horse papers and copies of membership cards will be charged an additional **\$10.00 fee** by the Show Secretary.

### 15. Items missing from the entry form are asked to bring those items to the show office when they check in. It is a lot of extra work to have them emailed, faxed or mailed prior to the show.

### 16. Entries must be post-marked no later than midnight, Wednesday, April 20, 2022 or emailed by midnight on Wednesday, April 20, 2022

### 17. Unrelated Owners In Owner Classes - For the purpose of showing in Junior Owner and Amateur Owner classes, two non-related owners will now be able to co-Own a horse and show in owner classes provided that :

- a. The Ownership must be an **AND** relationship – not an **OR** relationship.
- b. **No** family member of a professional may enter into this relationship.
- c. "Non-family owners" are defined as two distinct individuals who are not related as family as defined by EC.
- d. Family members of these two co-owners are **NOT** permitted to show in owner classes.
- e. Both co-owners must be members of EC/USEF and hold a valid Amateur card. *Refer to Equestrian Canada rules for more information!*

**18. NOTE:** ("A Glossary EC Rulebook), every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition (A602.7) **"By signing the entry form I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution & rules of Equestrian Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. "The person responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC. The person responsible is the trainer, owner or exhibitor (adults) who signs the entry form.**

## Memberships

1. All exhibitors entering Arabian and/or Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes at this show must hold a valid **AHA Competition membership** or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$35.00 US funds (equivalent is \$40 CDN) per person per show. This includes one owner, any trainer, driver, rider or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse.  
*Exception: Walk/Trot exhibitors (not in showmanship) – but MUST have a provincial membership and Parents or Guardians signing the form for minors,*
2. One owner, and all drivers, riders, lessees, agents or trainers must hold an **EC Sport License** and have paid an appropriate provincial horse federation levy or if a US citizen holds a valid US Equestrian Federation membership.  
*Please check the EC membership rules for 2022 for further rulings A207 & A208 & A216 for complete wording. This show requires full Equestrian Canada Sport License for Arabian, Morgan & American Saddlebred exhibitors, owners, riders, drivers, handlers etc. along with the PSO – i.e. AEF for Alberta participants.*  
*NOTE: Morgan Classes - are now Bronze*  
All Breed entries require **EC Sport Horse License to exhibit** for insurance purposes as they are EC approved classes.
3. **Amateur status** designation on an **EC Sport Horse License** is required for individuals wishing to exhibit in Amateur classes.  
You MUST apply for this card at the same time you apply for the Sport Horse License. **New** – no extra fee will be charged for Amateur Status.  
An Amateur is a person who, having attained the age of 19 (for show purpose) does not attempt to make a profit through equestrian activities; whose main source of income is not derived from equestrian activities which would make him/her professional. Amateur Owner is included in the Senior Competitive License fee, but must be applied for at an additional fee within a Competitive License. *Check current EC rules for any changes A207*
4. You are cordially invited to join Equestrian Canada - *check fees in the Current rule book as they may have changed (plus provincial levy on each membership and Amateur Status)* **Amateur status must be applied for and is included in your Sport Horse License at no fee.**  
**Alberta residents MUST purchase an AEF membership plus EC Sport License to show at all Arabian & HA/AA shows**  
**Please refer to the EC Rules for Membership changes. The Parkland Spring Show is "Bronze" recognized shows for Arabian & ASB Breeds.**  
(b) A Temporary Sport License is **NOT** available for this Bronze show. Please contact your PSO & Equestrian Canada directly.  
(c) A Single Event EC Sport License upgrade is for a competitor arriving at a competition without the correct EC Sport License level. The competitor pays a fee of \$20 to the competition to upgrade and compete at each level higher than their current license. The upgrade is valid only for that competition and does not accrue points. Permanent upgrades must be done directly through the EC office. (this will need to be done on your I-phone to EC)

5. For EC membership apply to: on line at [www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca). Provincial levies (if applicable) to be paid to the Alberta Equestrian Federation, Suite 100, 251 MidPark Blvd. SE, Calgary, Alberta T2X 1S3. **NO EC Memberships will be sold at this show office.** **Equestrian Canada requires a valid PSO membership number for all renewals and can be done on line.**

### EC Rules – Section A , Article 4213 – Exemptions – EC Sport Licenses

Foreign competitors are not required to hold EC Sport Licenses, provided they are members in good standing of another national federation recognized by the FEI. *Any riders competing in EC and CET medal classes must hold an EC Sport License*  
Canadians must purchase the appropriate EC Sport License in order to compete at an EC sanctioned competition in Canada.

## Class Specifications

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the current Rules and Specifications of Equestrian Canada and/or the AHA and will be held and judged in accordance with said rulebooks.
2. Exhibitors, Judges and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Full details of Show Horse Operation – EC (including FEI) rules – list of recognized Judges – other vital information is in the RULE BOOK copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. See current EC Rules and amendments. Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC Shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations in this Prize List.
3. The All-Breed open classes follow EC Open Rules unless otherwise stated.
4. **TBA – NEW** as of January 1, 2021 – AHA will charge a fee of \$15 USA funds (**\$20.00 CDN funds**) for any TBA that runs as a class – therefore that fee will be required to be paid for the TBA class along with the **\$25.00 class fee** for a total of \$45.00 Canadian.  
This fee is not applicable to American Saddlebred, All Breed or Morgan Classes.
5. **Arabian/HA/AA** - Participants may purchase **TBA classes** from the code list of Arabian and/or Half-Arabian/Anglo Arabian classes included in the CLASS section of the Classes listed by the AHA Handbook Class List. All classes may be purchased up to the session prior to when the class will be held.  
The Show Committee reserves the right to approve the class proposed for purchase.  
**TBA –American Saddlebred, All Breed & Morgan classes – Call show secretary at 403-227-0538 with the request to be approved by Show Committee and for the added class placement in the Tentative Schedule. The class fee is \$25.00 only.**
6. For the Arabian Division, Junior Horses are 5yrs and under as of January 1 of the current year. For Morgan and American Saddlebred classes, Junior Horses are 4yrs and under as of January 1, of the current year. Other breeds as per their rules and regulations.
7. **Arabian/HA/AA** - Individuals are AHA Junior Exhibitors if they have not yet reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to December 1<sup>st</sup> of the previous calendar year. Individuals are Juniors, according to EC, until the end of the calendar year in which they reach 18 yrs of age i.e. JOTR, JTR -18 & Under and AATR, AAOTR– are 19 & Over
8. ASB, AB or Morgan - Youth Exhibitors - are 21yrs of age or younger. Youth Exhibitors may show stallions, mares or geldings with the exception of the Arabian/HA/AA stallion halter/breeding classes. **Walk/trot, jog exhibitors** cannot cross enter into any class requiring a lope or canter and must be 11years or under. *Refer to EC rules for definition of youth & owner*

### **Class Specifications.... Continued**

9. Breeding In-hand Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian classes will use the Arabian Scoring System per current AHA handbook. In Hand Arabian & HA/AA Judges' cards have been modified, see AHA 2022 Handbook
10. Morgan Youth classes are open to exhibitors 21 years of age and under. Youth classes are judged in accordance with Open Classes and are open to stallions, mares and geldings. Youth Exhibitors in the Morgan Division may cross enter in all other Junior Exhibitor classes offered in each Show. Stallions are prohibited in Junior Exhibitor classes.
11. Participants in Morgan English Pleasure classes must wear Saddle Seat attire. Refer to B5602.2 for EC specs. on Attire.
12. Participants in All Breeds English Pleasure and Park must wear Saddle Seat attire.
13. Morgan Classic Pleasure horses may cross enter in all other Morgan English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving classes offered in each Show.
14. Arabian Country English Pleasure may not enter Arabian English Pleasure or Arabian Pleasure Driving classes at the same show. However, a Country English Pleasure horse could show Country English Pleasure one show of the weekend and English Pleasure the other show. All horses are eligible to enter the All Breeds English Pleasure classes.
15. **All Breeds English Pleasure STAKE** classes (see Awards #2) are open to Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian English Pleasure and Country English Pleasure horses; Morgan English Pleasure and Classic Pleasure horses; American Saddlebred Park, Three-Gaited, Pleasure, and Country Pleasure horses; and to horses of any other breed that have an English Pleasure division that exhibits in Saddle Seat attire. Horses entered must conform to their respective breed specifications for shoeing and horse age designation for the divisions permitted to show in the All Breed Stake classes. Amateur designation includes Adult and Junior riders. Junior horses are as per breed specifications. Novice horses cannot have won more than 3 first place ribbons in the Division entered. No qualifying class required. Horses must walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring.  
There are **no qualifying classes** for **All Breeds Western Pleasure** and **All Breeds Hunter Pleasure** Stakes classes. Horses entered must conform to their respective breed specifications for shoeing and horse age designation for All Breed Western, Hunter and Show Hack divisions. Amateur designation includes Adult and Junior riders. Junior horses are as per breed specifications. Novice horses cannot have won more than 3 first place ribbons in the Division entered. No qualifying class required.  
**All Breed Western Pleasure horses** will be asked to walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring and will be asked to back. Hunter Pleasure horses will be asked to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and may be asked to back. Extended gaits may be called for.  
**All Breeds English Show Hack horses** will be asked to walk, trot, canter (normal, collected and extended gaits) and hand gallop (collectively) both ways of the ring, and will be asked to back.  
**All Breeds Equitation classes** will be conducted according to EC general Articles pertaining to Stock Seat Equitation, Hunter Seat on the Flat and Saddle Seat Equitation.
16. AHA Medal Class Specifications are now located in the EC/USEF Rulebook and are no longer required to be printed in the prize List. Please refer to the Arabian Division Chapter for rules & class specs.  
**AHA Medal classes** with pattern must be held regardless of number of competitors. An AHA Medal class must have a minimum of three (3) competitors with proper appointments in order to have an AHA Medal awarded. For AHA Medal classes with fewer than three (3) competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned.
17. **Adult Equitation** classes have been added. AATR Equitation classes are 19yrs & Over and follow the same equitation rules as the junior classes. See AHA Handbook. However, Adult equitation exhibitors are **not** allowed to enter the AHA Medal classes.
18. Patterns will be posted at least one hour before the class at the Show Office and in an area designated by the Show Committee.
18. Substitution of a horse will be handled on an individual basis
19. All Morgan classes are Equine Canada rated "Bronze".

#### **20. Lead Line 2-Tyrs old - NO FEE -- can enter at show office one session before the class.**

**Signature of Parent or Guardian is mandatory (not EC rated) Lead Line youth are not allowed to enter performance classes.**

1. Safety is the main priority
2. Child must wear a helmet
3. The lead line must be attached to the halter and not to the bridle bit.
4. Saddle must fit child with feet in stirrups
5. Person leading horse must be 14 yrs or older
6. **Horse must be entered in the show.**

**Does NOT require a Provincial or EC membership – However, AEF suggests that these exhibitors and handlers have the AEF membership for insurance benefits. Contact AEF for more information.**

21. Junior exhibitors may not show stallions in All Breed classes, showmanship or equitation. Refer to breed-specific classes for the rules of each breed organization shall apply with respect to Junior competitors exhibiting stallions.
22. EC Article A905.2 states that Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds. Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable. EC Article A905.1 strongly recommends that all persons wear approved headgear at all times while mounted or driving cross country or marathon. However, at present, if a Junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc) those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty and we urge their members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western classes but they are recommended. Approved headgear is mandatory in all over fences classes. Hunt Seat on the flat must wear approved helmets complete with harness.  
*"Note: A helmet is required in Hunt Seat Equitation as per EC rules. Juniors are strongly advised to wear helmets until just before they enter the show ring in any division."*  
**All Breed Juniors must wear a helmet EC Rule A802.6**

### **Class Specifications.... continued**

23. Hor Concour is allowed, unless specific breed rules indicate otherwise -- exception -- Dressage and Hunter Over Fences.  
. Hor Concour entries are not eligible for any awards.  
These entries must pay the same fee and are subject to the same conditions that apply to regular class entries.  
Show secretary must be advised of the Hor Concour entry before shown. A214.3
24. AHA SWEEPSTAKES POINTS PROGRAM has been discontinued. Please refer to the AHA 2022 Handbook for the **participation based system**.
25. Arabian Achievement Leveling is in effect for Park, English Pleasure, Country English Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, Western Pleasure and Trail.  
For complete information refer to your AHA 2022 handbook.
26. SELECT ATR – Arabian/HA/AA Classes – REFER to EC Rules 2022 — Changes have been made for this division – It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the specifications for each class/each division entered.
27. Morgan Ladies Classes are for lady riders/drivers over 18yrs of age.
28. A testing drug fee charge of \$5.00 – Bronze - for each entered horse and is included on the entry form.
29. *\*EC statement – Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing. A602.5*

### **Awards**

1. Regular Halter, Performance and Stake Classes will be placed 1<sup>st</sup>- 6<sup>th</sup> per AHA results rules and all will receive ribbons to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
2. All Breeds Stake Classes (as per EC Rules) will receive ribbons and prize money to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Seventy five percent (75%) of the entry fees will be paid out as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place – 35%; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 25%; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 20%; 4<sup>th</sup> place - 15%; 5<sup>th</sup> place - 5%. If there are fewer than 5 horses entered and shown, payout will remain as stated. Cheques will be issued to the horse owner(s) and will be mailed within 60 days of the end of the show.

### **Stabling**

**FOR SAFETY REASONS NO PERSON IS ALLOWED TO TIE A HORSE TO THE EXTERIOR OF ANY STALL OR CROSS-TIE ANY HORSE IN THE ALLEY-WAY FOR ANY REASON.  
THIS MEANS NO GROOMING, TACKING UP, FARRIER WORK etc AT ANY TIME DAY OR NIGHT.  
PERSON RESPONSIBLE WILL ASSUME ALL RISKS AND LIABILITIES.**

**This will definitely be enforced at this Parkland Spring Show**

1. Exhibitors cancelling their entries after the closing date (Wednesday, April 20, 2022) shall forfeit their stall fees.
  2. Stabling will be available from 8:00 a.m., May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Stalls must be vacated no later than Midnight – May 22, 2022, unless other arrangements are made with Parkland/Western.
- Stabling is only guaranteed to those who submit their stabling requirements with their Entry Forms before the Entry Deadline. Do not assume that you will be able to obtain stalls if you arrive at the Show and have not entered prior to the Entry Deadline. Those who have booked stall(s), but wish to add stall(s) after the Entry Deadline are not guaranteed that additional stalls will be in the same area of the stalls that were initially requested and assigned.*
3. There is a **\$150.00 per Stall or \$ 130.00 per Tack Room** for the full 3 days. No stall will be held without full payment and all stalls will be allocated by the Stabling Manager. **Shavings are supplied with the stall fee however, please use sparingly!**
  4. **Dressage or Sport Horse entries** will be allowed **one night** stabling at **\$100.00** – i.e. arrive after 4:00 pm on May 20 (Friday) and leave by 8:00 p.m. on May 21, 2022 (Saturday) \*\* may be in a designated area only\*\*
  5. **Working Hunter/Jumper entries** will be allowed **one night** stabling at **\$100.00** – i.e. arrive after 4:00 pm on May 21- Saturday and leave by end of classes on May 22,2022 (Sunday). May be in a designated area only.
- Full stabling fee is required for entries that are in both Sport Horse & Dressage Classes and/or Sport Horse & Working Hunter Classes.**
6. The number of stalls are limited so please be considerate in your request for Tack Rooms. All Tack Rooms are subject to forfeit, if conditions warrant.
  7. **New: If you move stall fronts for tack room or sitting area, they MUST be put back in the original position or you will be billed by the Westerner.**
  8. Exhibitors shall not move from their assigned stalls or trade without permission of the Show Manager. Violation of this rule will result in the removal of the proposed competitor from the Show without refund of any kind. This rule will be strictly enforced.
  9. **There are NO Day Stalls NOR any Haul In**
  10. **Shavings are included in the stall price.** They are available at the end of each tent/barn. Bring your own wheelbarrow or large muck bucket, and bed your own stalls. **Please be considerate with the amount of shavings used.**
  11. It is mandatory that the stabling area be kept clean - there are large waste disposal boxes at each end of every tent/barn.
  12. The ends of each stabling tent are not for the exclusive use of those with stalls in the immediate area. They are for everyone's use to store carts etc. Anyone limiting the use of these areas by other exhibitors, by any means, may be asked to correct the situation by the Show Manager.
- 13. **There will be NO hay or straw available for purchase at the Parkland Spring Show.**

## General

1. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to decide on any point not governed by the rules to correct any error or make any necessary alterations to the Rules, Prize List or Program.
2. Barn calls are a courtesy only. Exhibitors must check in with the Gate Attendant before the class is called to enter the ring. Those exhibitors who have not checked in, may be stopped from entering the ring. Exhibitors must enter the ring promptly when called. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. Those not ready when called will not be allowed to enter the ring once the gate is closed.
3. Gate holds will be granted at the discretion of Show Management and must be requested through the Show Office well before the class, preferably before the beginning of the session prior to requiring the gate hold.
4. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Officials by an owner, groom, rider or driver, the owner may forfeit the entry fee and as such will be reported to the Horse Show Committee and/or EC and/or AHA. The Committee reserves the right to itself, the power to remove any groom, horse, rider, family member or persons associated with any horse or rider from the show grounds without being liable for compensation.
5. No person other than Officials, the Steward and Attendants on duty may enter the Show Ring without permission of the Horse Show Committee.
6. Grooms entering the ring are required to be neatly attired.
7. Any exhibitor using the wrong number, or having no number in the ring may be excused from the class. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that they are wearing the correct number in the class. Competition numbers must be worn & visible at all times. Please come to the show office to get a duplicate number if required.
8. Cruelty to or abuse of any horses by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of a whip on any horse anywhere on the show grounds before or during the show by any person constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.
9. If any exhibitor has an outstanding debt to the Parkland Arabian Horse Assoc., the Show Committee reserves the right to entry to the Show.

10. **Important** All dogs must be kept on a leash on the show grounds.

**Dogs are NOT allowed in the Agricentre Pavillion or the hitching ring at any time by order of the Westerner Park.**

11. Bikes/Scooters/ Skate Boards are **NOT** to be ridden in the Barns or around the hitching ring area.

12. **Westerner Park has a campground that is operated independently.** You may be asked to pay a fee if you have a trailer parked near the barn that appears to have living quarters, even if it is **NOT** plugged in. You may also be asked to move your trailer if it is parked beside a barn and not plugged in. Contact [westernercampground.com](http://westernercampground.com) to prebook your RV or Horse Trailer with living quarters spot or telephone 403-352-8801.

13. **AGE SPLITS: The Age Splits for AHA Junior Classes will be 14yrs & Under and 15-18years.**

## Judging

The Judge's decision is final in all classes. No one will approach the Judge with regard to a decision unless he or she first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place. No person may enter the space set apart for the Judge or hold communication with the Judge or examining Veterinarian without permission.

To qualify for judging, exhibitors must appear in the ring suitably attired and wearing the proper number plainly visible. Grooms and attendants must be appropriately attired.

- Primary vaccinations must be given in accordance with manufacturer recommendations
- Boosters vaccinations must be provided annually (every 12 months) thereafter
- Vaccination must be administered within 6 months (plus 21 days) of ARRIVING at the competition
- BUT NOT within 7 days (1 week before) of arrival to the competition
- MAKE A PLAN WITH YOUR VET!



#### HOW?

- EC will require that all responsible persons must declare compliance with vaccination requirements on their entry form
- Individual competitions can require proof of vaccination
- Proof of vaccination can be in the form of a veterinarian's receipt or invoice
- If you administer your own vaccinations, you must provide a receipt, batch number, and date of administration
- ALWAYS CARRY YOUR PROOF OF VACCINATION WITH YOU!

*All entry forms must contain the following statement, which must be signed by the person(s) responsible (See Glossary – Person(s) responsible): "I hereby certify that every horse listed on this entry form has met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations"*
