



The ASHA of Alberta 50/50 Cash Raffle Rules for AGLC License 598016

Up to \$10,000 prize – Draw July 16 – start of evening classes – Calnash Ag Event Center

Tickets can only be sold and purchased in Alberta, must be 18 years of age to purchase

The rules will comply with the terms and conditions set out by AGLC and will be posted on the raffle webpage and on the American Saddlebred Horse Association of Alberta (ASHAofA) website, www.saddlebredsofAlberta.com.

1. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Rafflebox from May 12, 2022 to July 16, 2022, 4:00 pm or until ticket sales reach the capped limit of \$20,000.
2. 6750 total tickets will be sold in the following packages:
 - Series A: 1 for \$10, 75 single tickets available
 - Series B: 4 for \$20, 325 packages available
 - Series C: 10 for \$40, 100 packages available
 - Series D: 25 for \$50, 175 packages available
3. Tickets purchasers must be 18 years or older to play and be within the province of Alberta when purchasing a ticket.
4. The person(s) drawing the winning number must not hold a ticket for that draw. ASHAofA and Alberta Charity Horse Show employees, directors, and volunteers, their family and friends are eligible to purchase tickets.
5. All ticket numbers will be emailed to ticket purchasers by the registered Electronic Raffle Supplier (ERS) (Rafflebox). A physical ticket will not be mailed out for this draw.
6. All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason.
7. All purchasers are advised to save in their files their uniquely-numbered raffle ticket numbers produced electronically at the time of purchase as proof of purchase until after the result of the Draw is announced.
8. By purchasing tickets, winners consent to having their name and winning numbers published on the “Winners” tab found on the main raffle page, ASHAofA’s website (www.saddlebredsofAlberta.com) and social media pages.
9. The winner will be determined by a random draw utilizing an Alberta Gaming Liquor Commission (AGLC) registered Electronic Raffle Supplier (ERS) Random Number Generator (RNG) prior to the opening ceremony of the Alberta Charity Horse Show’s evening classes at the Calnash AG Event Centre located at 3611 Hwy 2A, Ponoka AB. However, since the draw is online, the RNG dashboard may be operated at another location within Alberta due to currently unforeseen circumstances. Two of the ASHAofA board members will be in attendance to witness the draw.
10. The winner will receive a cash prize of 50% of ticket sales up to a maximum of \$10,000. The total prize will be based on the number of tickets sold.
11. The winner will be notified by the ASHAofA by phone and/or email within 7 days of being drawn.
12. To claim the prize, the holder of the winning ticket will have 30 days from the draw date to present the winning ticket and government issued photo identification and address. The prize will be awarded after the claimant has signed a Declaration and Release which must be executed and returned to the ASHAofA no later than 5 business days after the receipt of the Declaration of Release. The certified winner will receive a cheque in the amount of the declared prize. The prize must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions.
13. If more than one name is written on winning ticket stub, the prize shall be awarded to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket. The ASHAofA and the Alberta Gaming Liquor and Cannabis Commission are not responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on the ticket stub.
14. In the event that the name of a minor is on a ticket and wins a prize, the prize will be turned over to the Public Trustee for him or her to administer on behalf of the minor until the person reaches the age of eighteen (18) years.
15. Unauthorized persons copying, selling, or altering tickets are subject to prosecution. A 50/50 Raffle ticket will be void and a Prize not paid/redeemed if there is proof that the ticket was stolen, not issued, ineligible, altered, counterfeit, defective, printed in duplicate, or printed/produced in error. Horse Association of Alberta is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets or tickets redeemed in error by their agents.
